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Please note: All productions to be filmed in Bombay Beach, Niland & Slab City require approval by Imperial County Fire, with other locations subject to the same. Instructions will be provided by ICFC.

General Conditions:

Permittee agrees to the terms and conditions noted on the film permit and protocol. ICFC may terminate this permit at any time if permittee fails to perform any covenant herein contained. No alteration or variation of the terms of this permit shall be valid unless made in writing and approved by ICFC. Permittee agrees to comply with all rules and regulations of the facility or institution where filming will take place. Permit must be onsite during filming. ICFC makes no representation or warranty as to condition of any property or facilities utilized by permittee. It is the responsibility of permittee to fully inspect all such property and facilities to determine its condition prior to its use and may be required to return the sites to its original condition prior to filming. Going forward assumes all risks associated with the condition of property and/or facilities.

Indemnification: To the fullest extent permitted by law, Permittee shall indemnify and save the Imperial County Film Commission, County of Imperial and other entities associated with the production, free and harmless of and from all claims, demands, losses and liability, including cost and legal fees, arising directly or indirectly out of obligations undertaken in connection with this permit, or the issuance thereof, excepting only claims arising from the sole negligence or misconduct of the above-mentioned entities.

Imperial County COVID-19 Filming Protocols

- All productions, including print ads, are required to comply with State of California and Imperial County guidance orders pertaining to workplace safety. This is to include the health and Safety Guidelines for Motion Picture, Television and Streaming Productions (provided in the White Paper).
- All productions will make Imperial County's public health and safety a priority in all decision making, including but not limited to, if cast or crew members were to become ill while in the County. It is the responsibility of the production company to notify Imperial County Public Health (IC Public Health) and Imperial County Film Commission if one becomes ill, returns home and or is seen by a local hospital/physician/clinic. This is to include notification to both agencies if crew member is tested and is positive.
- All production companies will provide its designated COVID-19 compliance officer contact information, as well as and their crews as per the filming Health & Safety Guidelines.
- All production companies will be required to sign this protocol prior to being issued a filming permit.
